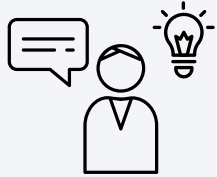

40% of S-OP adjunct faculty are Black, Indigenous and People of Color (BIPOC) and we stay **committed to increasing diversity** in our faculty.



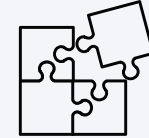
*We are similar to but **distinct** from programs in I/O Psychology, Organizational Behavior & Business Administration (MBA).*

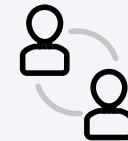
